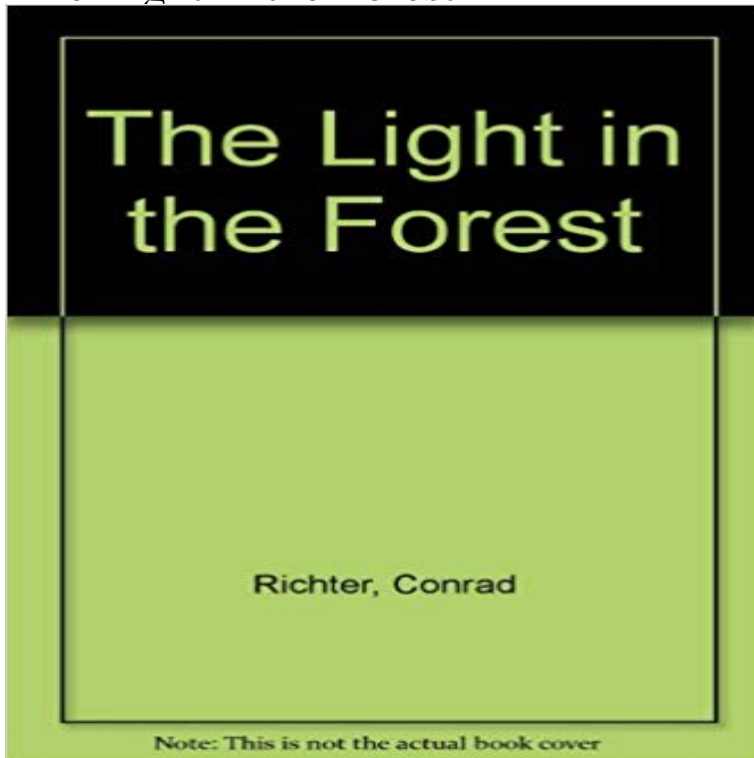


The Light in the Forest
