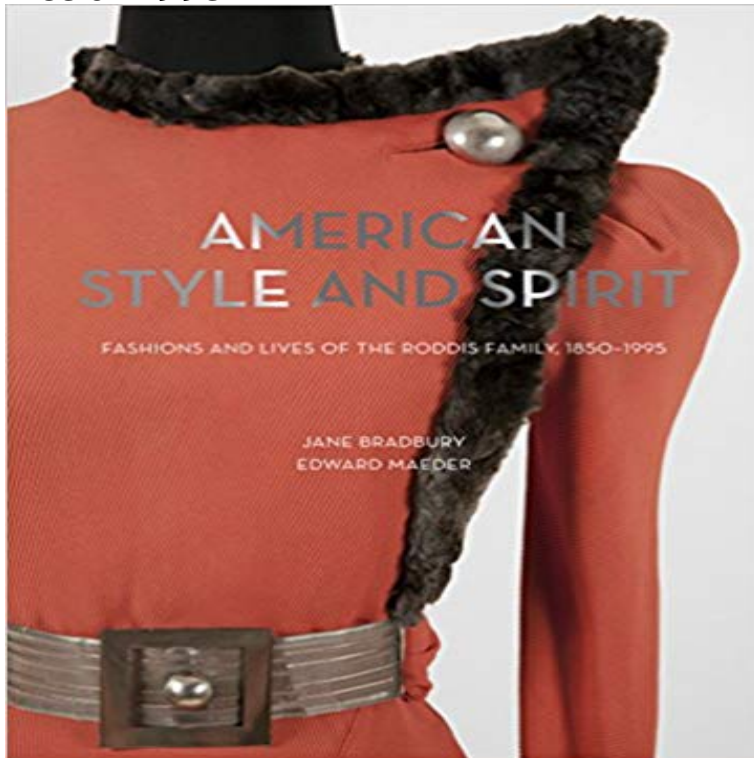


American Style and Spirit: Fashions and Lives of the Roddis Family, 1850–1995
