As both women move within the flamboyant milieu of Regency England, the political turmoil of the era is matched by the scheming Becky's sensational rise and its unforeseen aftermath. Based in part upon Thackeray's own love for the wife of a friend, *Vanity Fair* portrays the hypocrisy and corruption of high society and the dangers of unrestrained ambition with epic brilliance and scathing wit.
