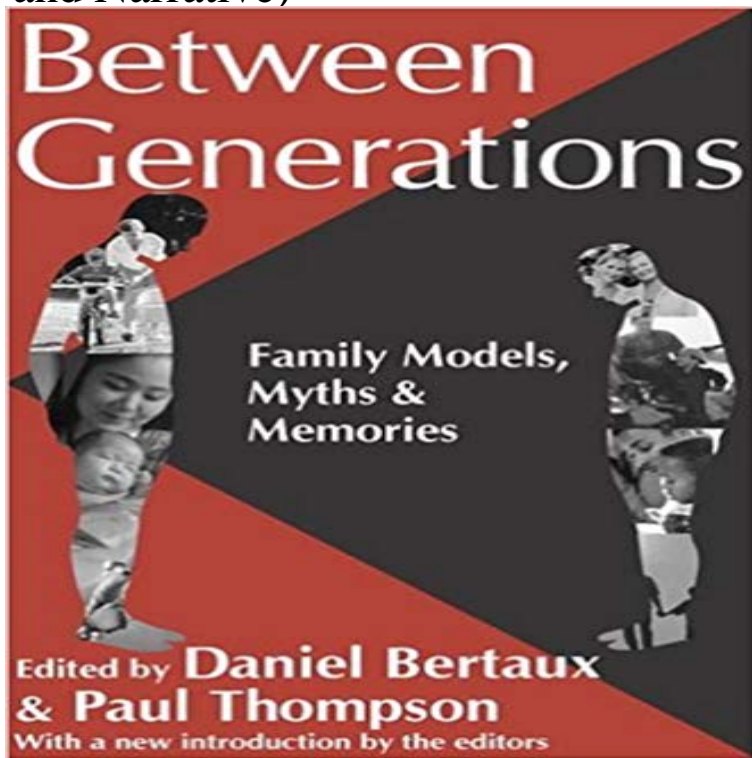


# Between Generations: Family Models, Myths, and Memories (Memory and Narrative)
