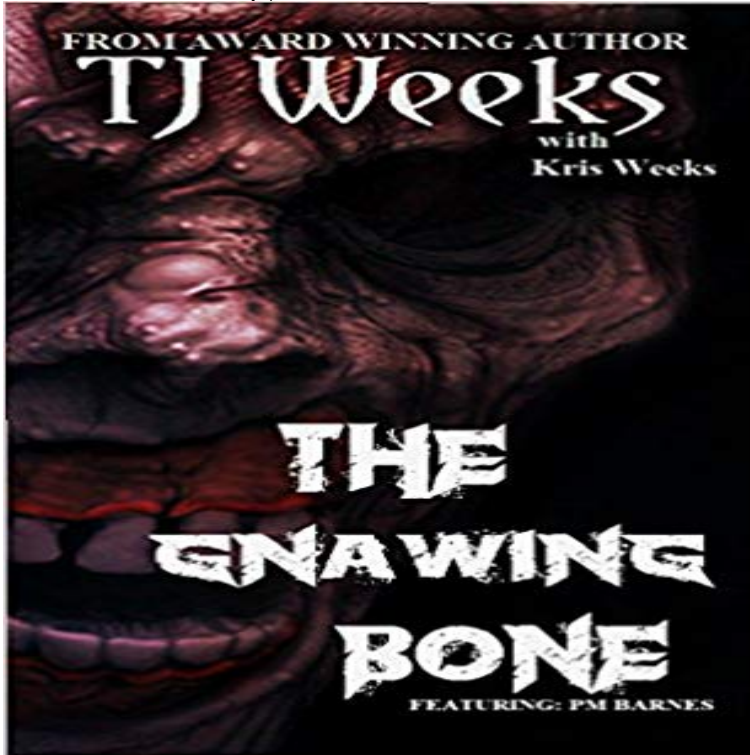


# The Gnawing Bone
