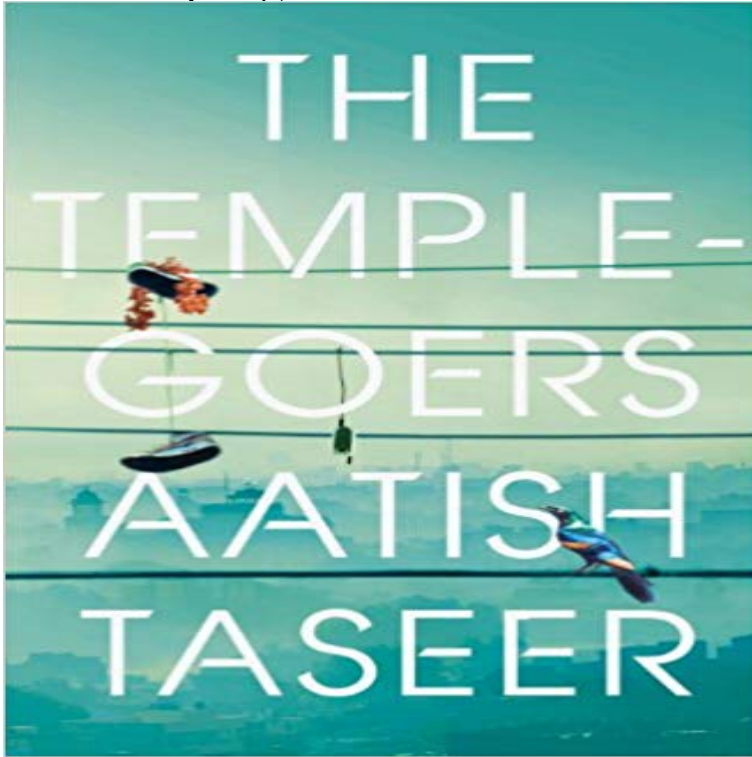


## The Temple-goers
