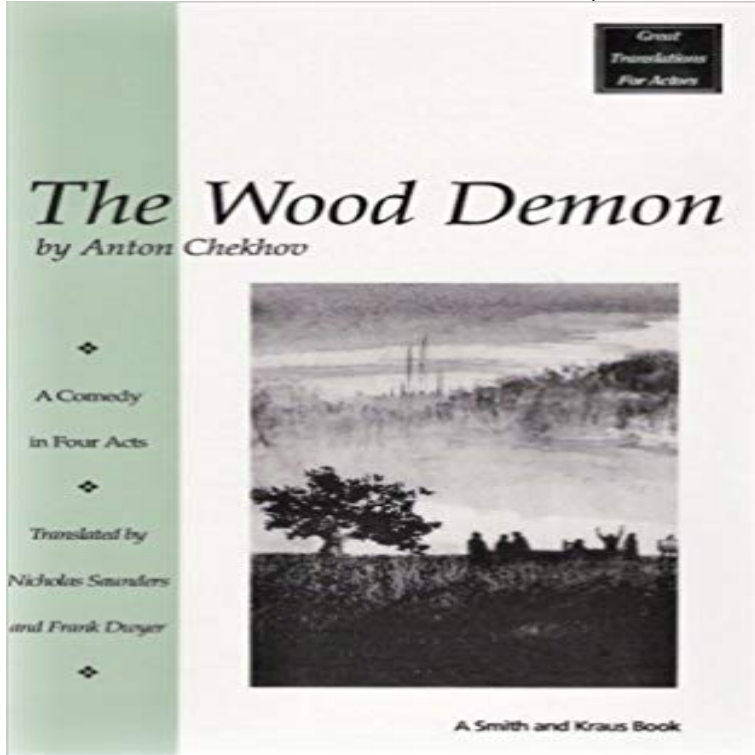


The Wood Demon: A Comedy in Four Acts
