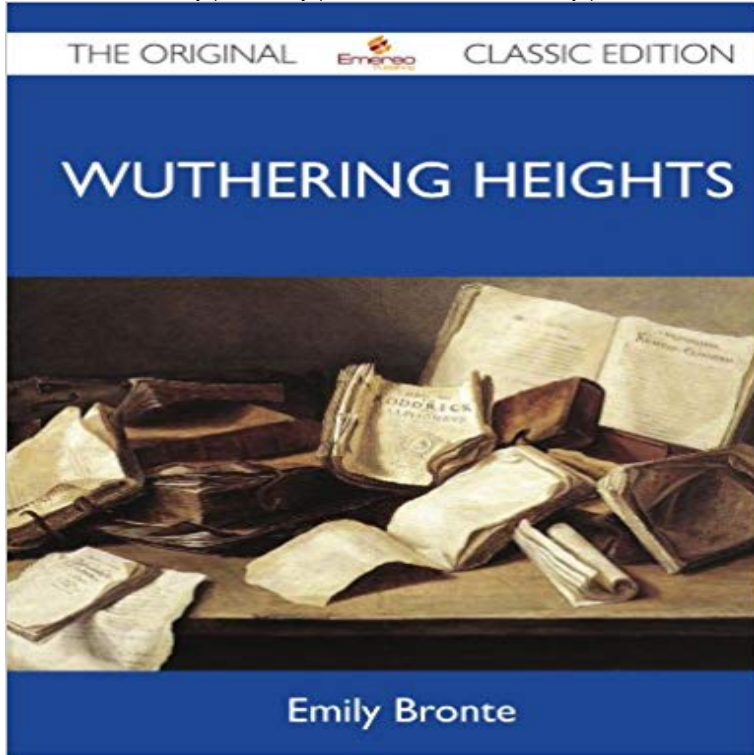


Wuthering Heights - The Original Classic Edition

extinguished the flames with heaps of cinders.
