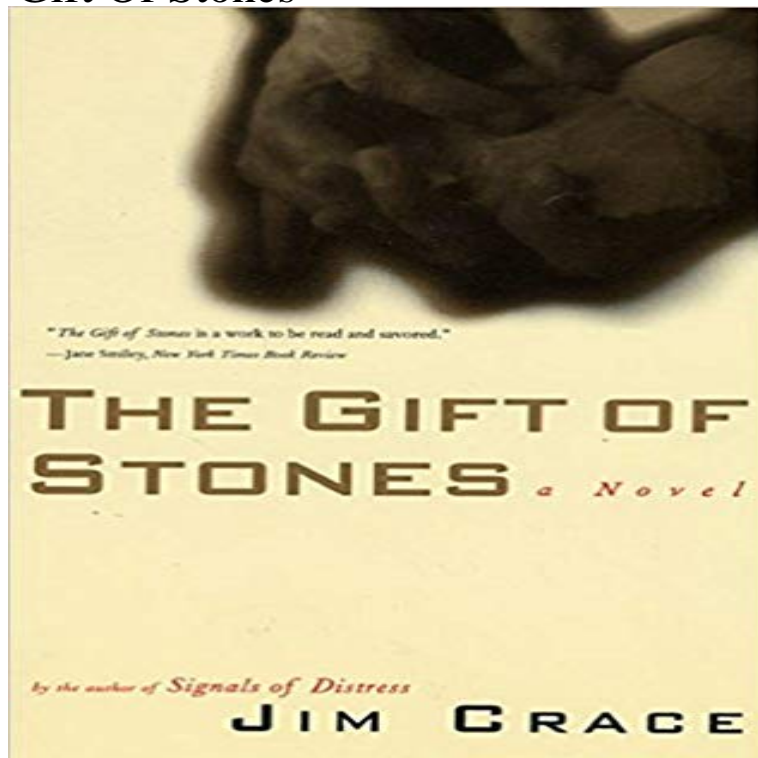


# Gift Of Stones
