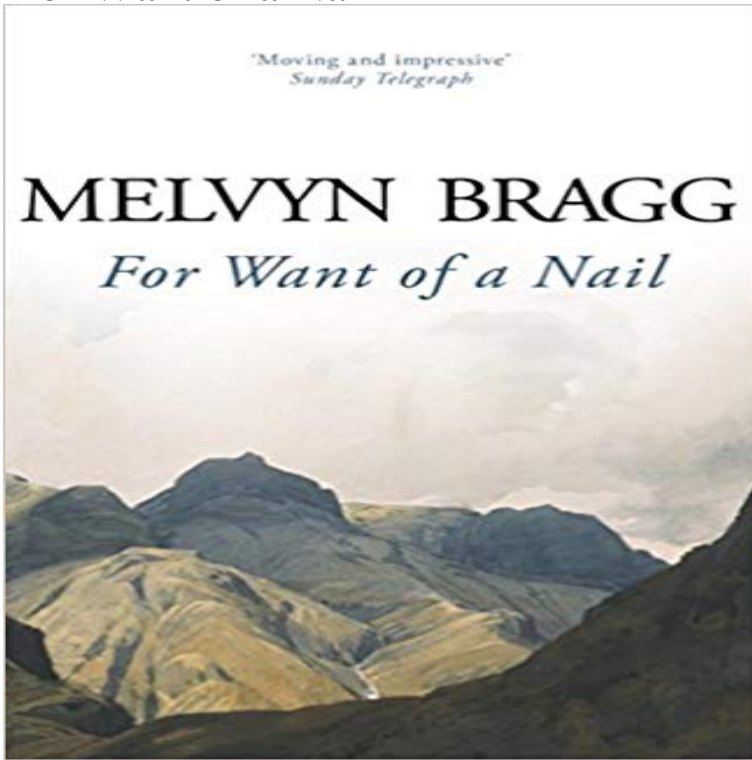


For Want of a Nail
