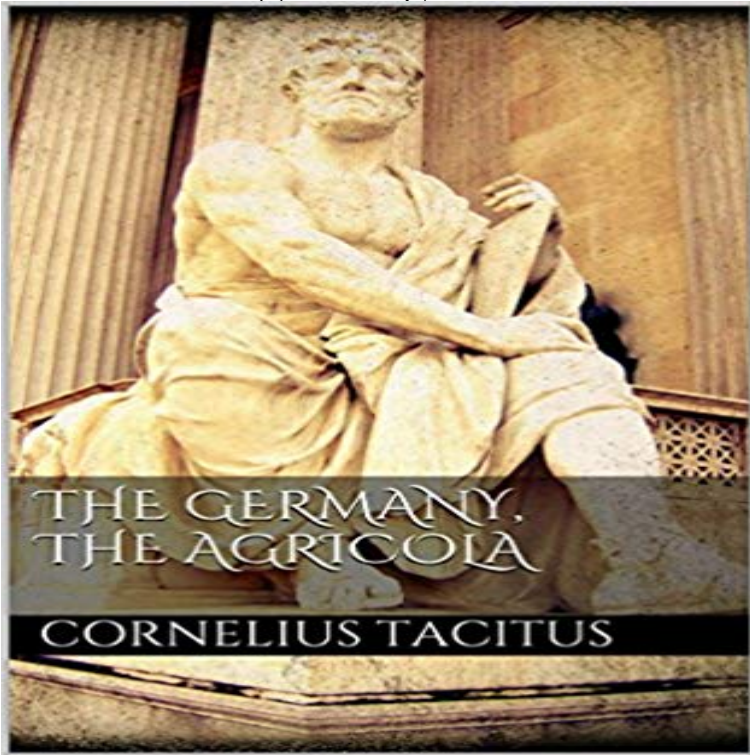


# The Germany, the Agricola
