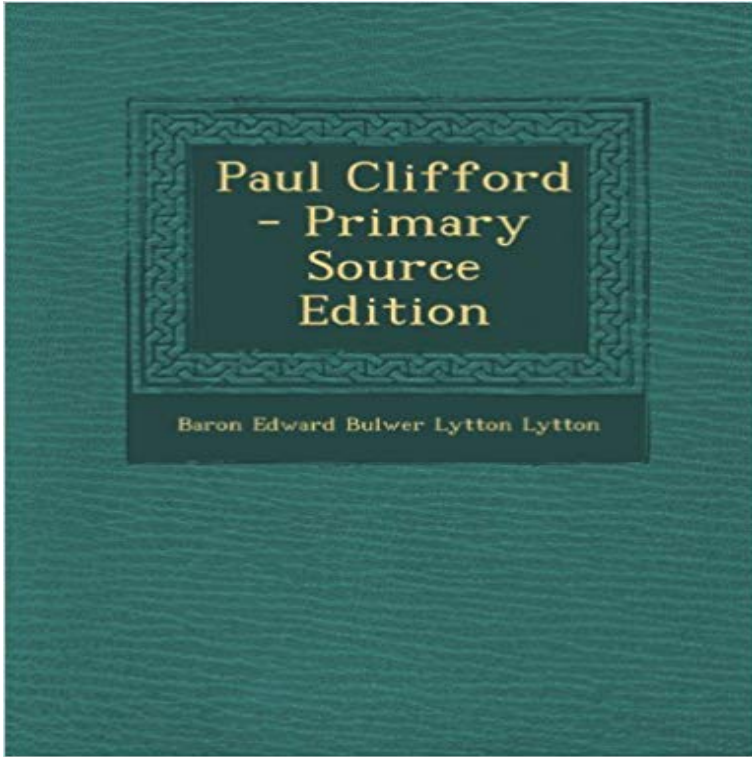


Paul Clifford
