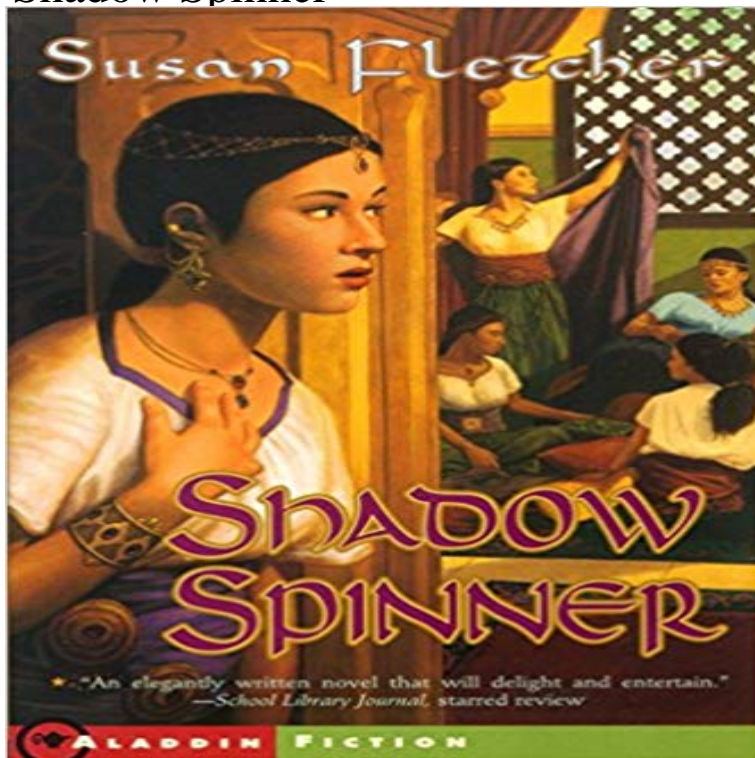


Shadow Spinner
