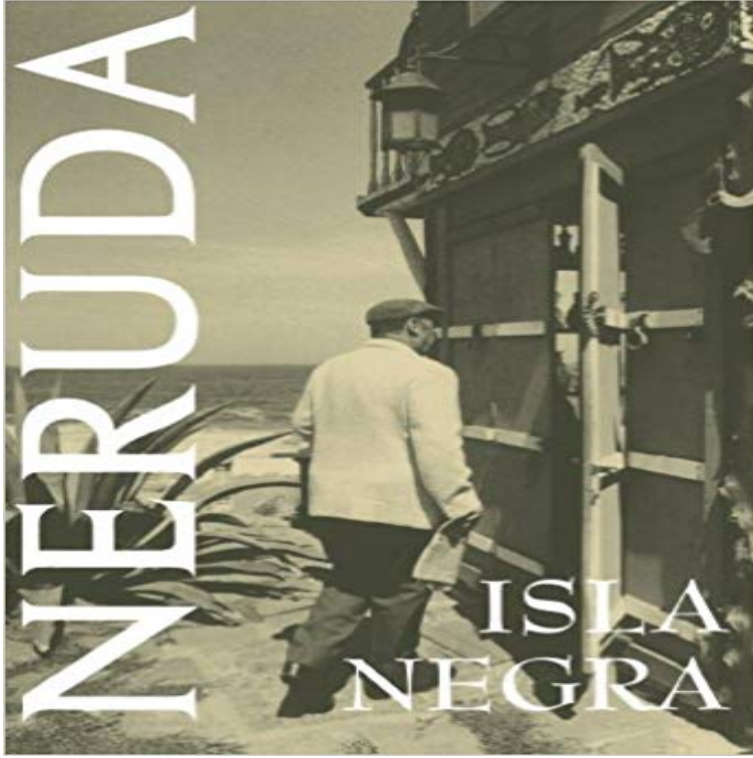


Isla Negra (White Pine Poetry Prize)
