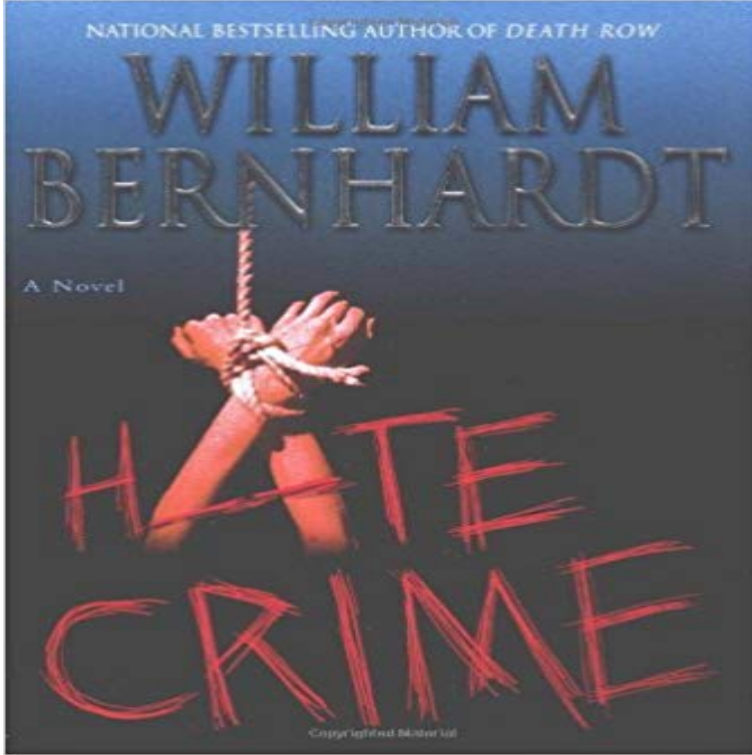


Hate Crime (Ben Kincaid series Book 13)
