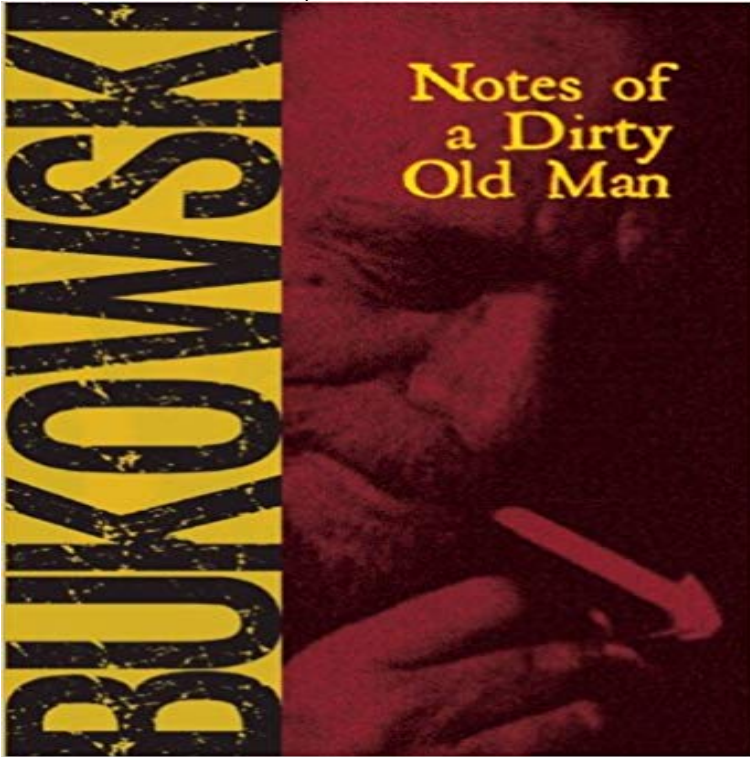


Notes of a Dirty Old Man
