


Travels With a Penguin Book 4: Japan & Sri Lanka: How One Baby Boomer Took a Year Off to Follow Her Dreams and Travel Round the World With Only a Penguin for Company



Continuing the world travel adventures of Pen Quiller and Scott-the-penguin! Pen, who describes her pre-adventure self as an ordinary woman in her fifties leading an unremarkable life in suburban England, realized one day that she was liking her life less and less, and made the decision that she wasn't going to let her dreams go unfulfilled any longer. Determined not to let the sentence 'One day I'm going to remain unfinished,' she left her job, sold her home and set off to discover the world, her only companion a small, stuffed penguin named Scott of the Antarctic. And the Travels with a Penguin series was born! She crosses the USA in Book 1, reunites with her best friend to discover New Zealand in Book 2, and treks up the east coast of Australia in Book 3. Now, in the final book in the series, Travels with a Penguin, Book 4, Pen and Scott conquer two new countries on their bucket list. In Japan, they search for Mount Fuji, cross rice fields on the bullet train, see hot springs and thundering waterfalls and take a day trip to a place called Hell. Pen dresses as a Japanese bride, bathes her feet in a hot stream in the middle of a forest, and hand feeds wild deer. She also visits Hiroshima, leaving there profoundly affected by the City of Peace. Then it's the scenic route to Sri Lanka, where Pen and Scott take a spin in a tuk-tuk, see elephants bathing in a river, and get to feed one banana while riding on her back. Pen sees leopards on safari, visits beautiful beaches, learns about the aftermath of the 2004 tsunami, and has a very British tea on the lawn in a summer retreat built in the nineteenth century. The highlight of her trip is the fulfilment of a long held dream: to see the ancient sites of Sigiriya and Anuradhapura, which she first read about in Arthur C. Clarke's novel *The Fountains of Paradise* when she was a teenager. At the end of her trip, arriving back in England again, Pen looks back on how

taking the chance to live her dreams has changed her and finishes by encouraging all of you out there to look at your own wish list and maybe start living a dream or two of your own. After all, as she says, if she can do it perhaps you can, too. Whats on YOUR bucket list?
