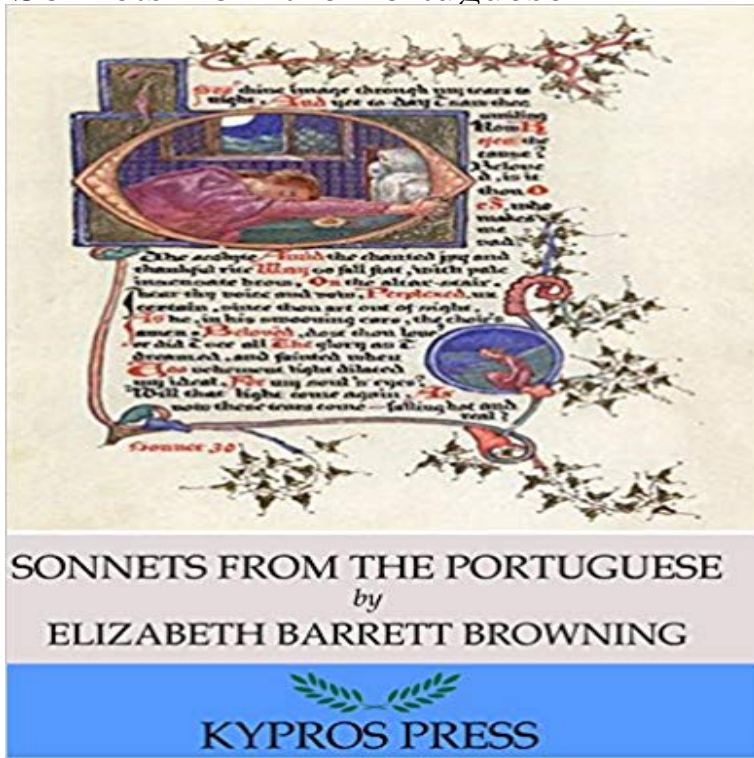


# Sonnets from the Portuguese
