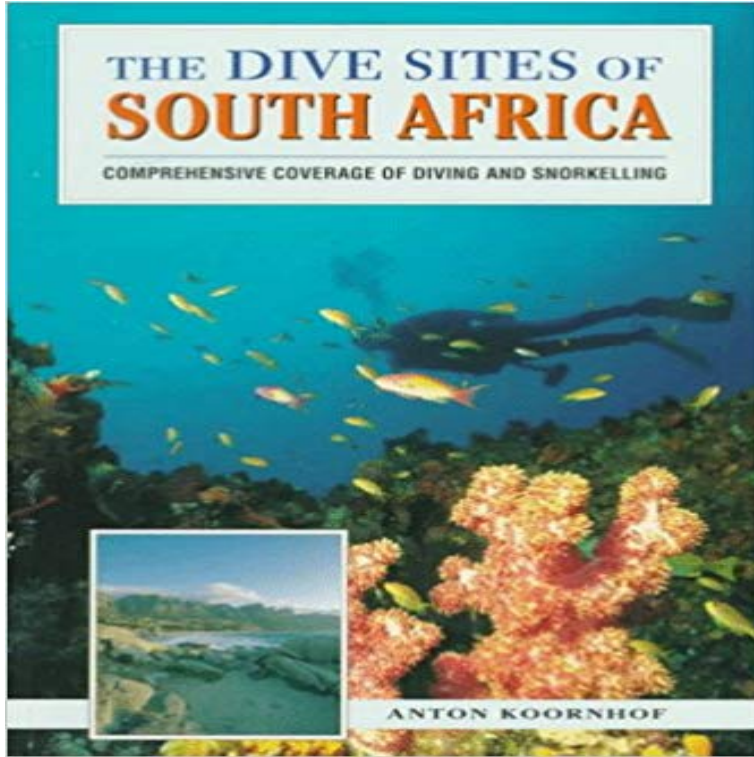


The Dive Sites of South Africa
