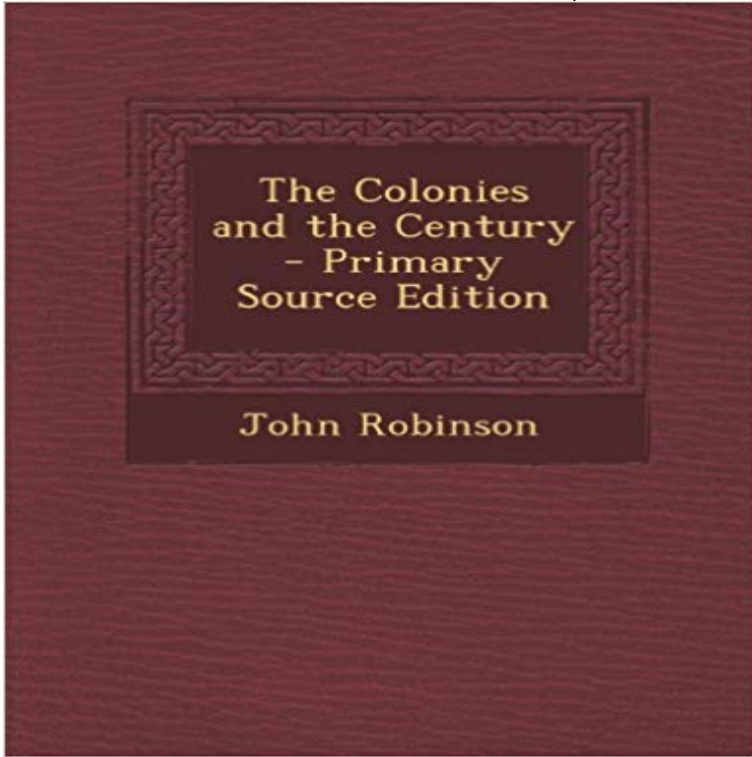


# The Colonies and the Century - Primary Source Edition
