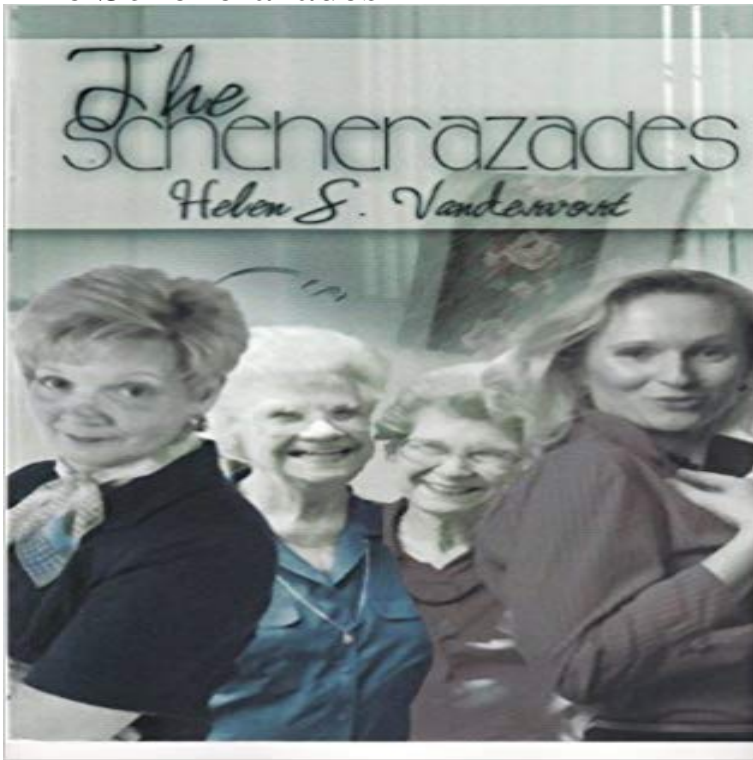


The Scheherazades
