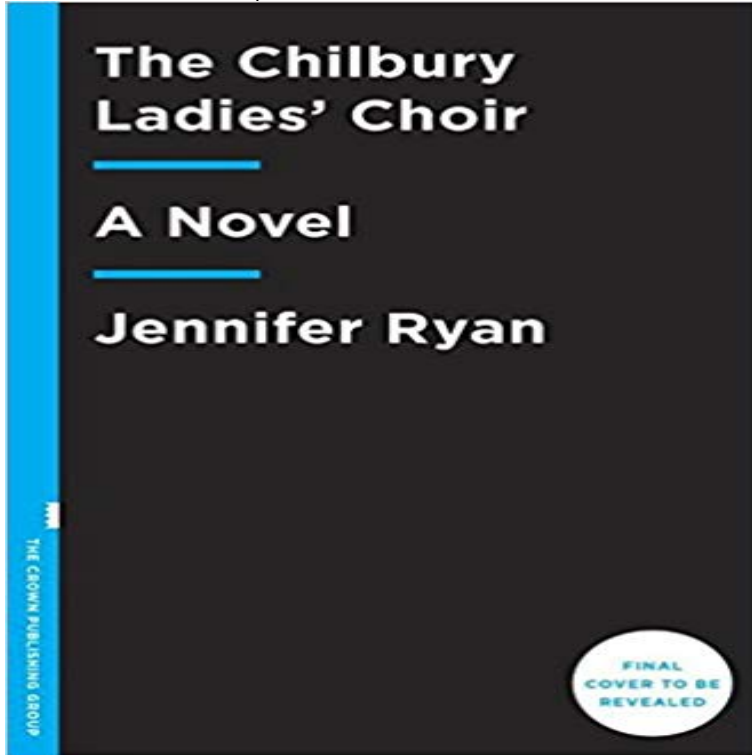


The Chilbury Ladies Choir: A Novel
