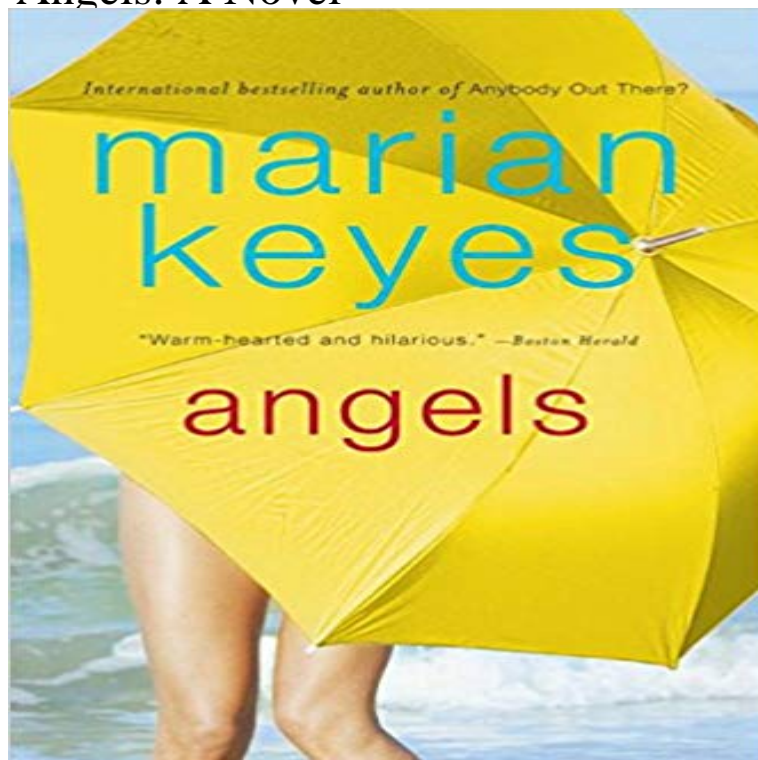


Angels: A Novel
