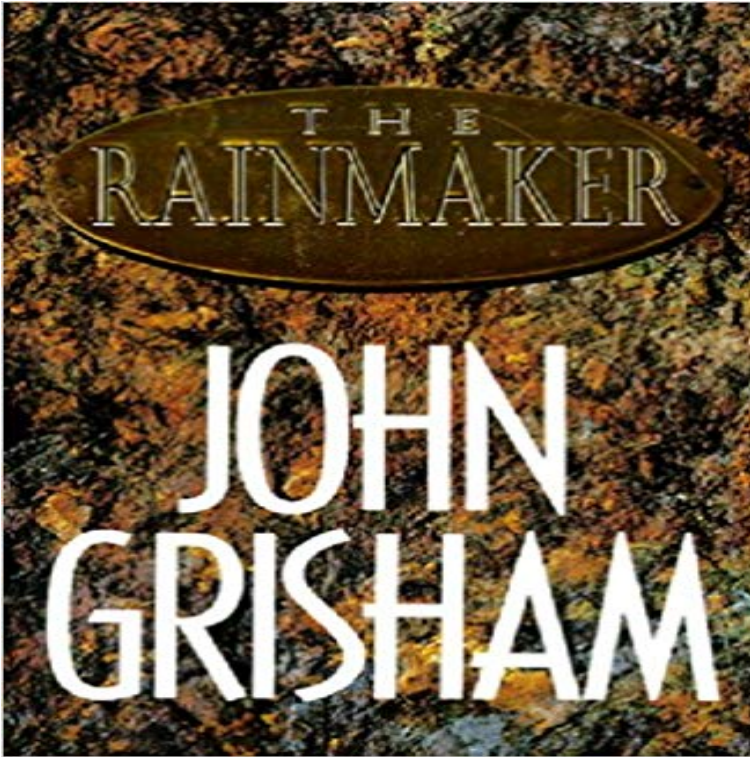


The Rainmaker
