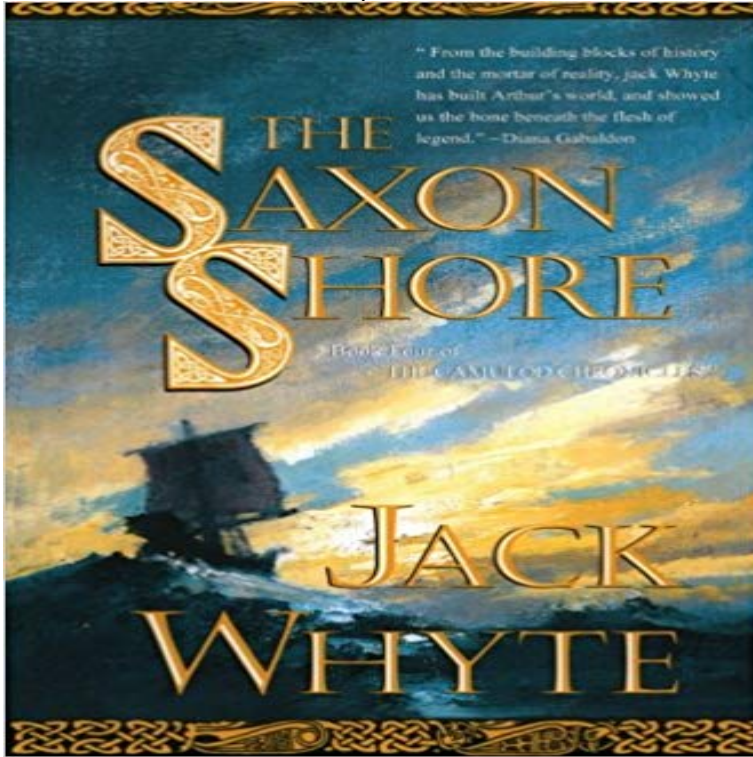


The Saxon Shore (The Camulod Chronicles, Book 4)
