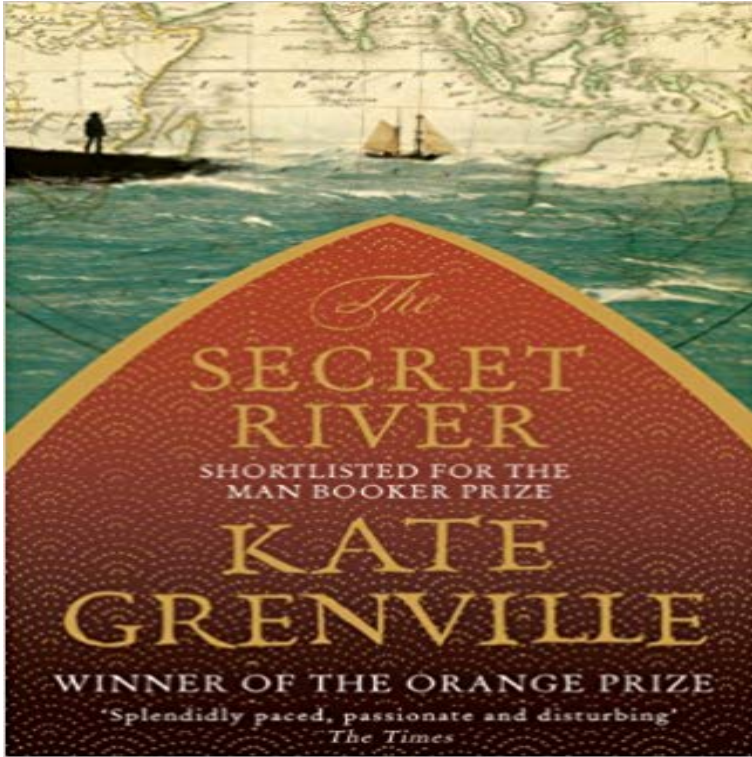


The Secret River
