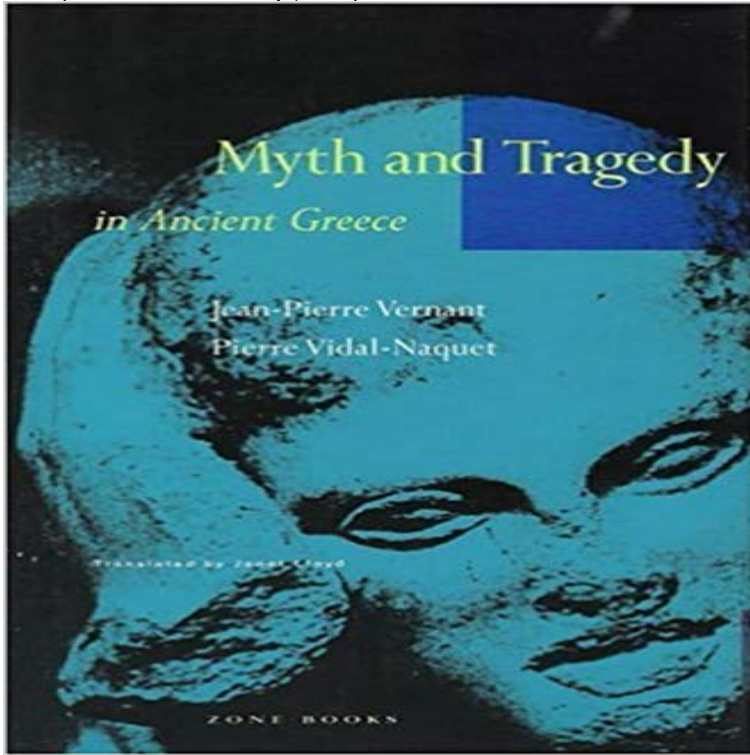


# Myth and Tragedy in Ancient Greece
