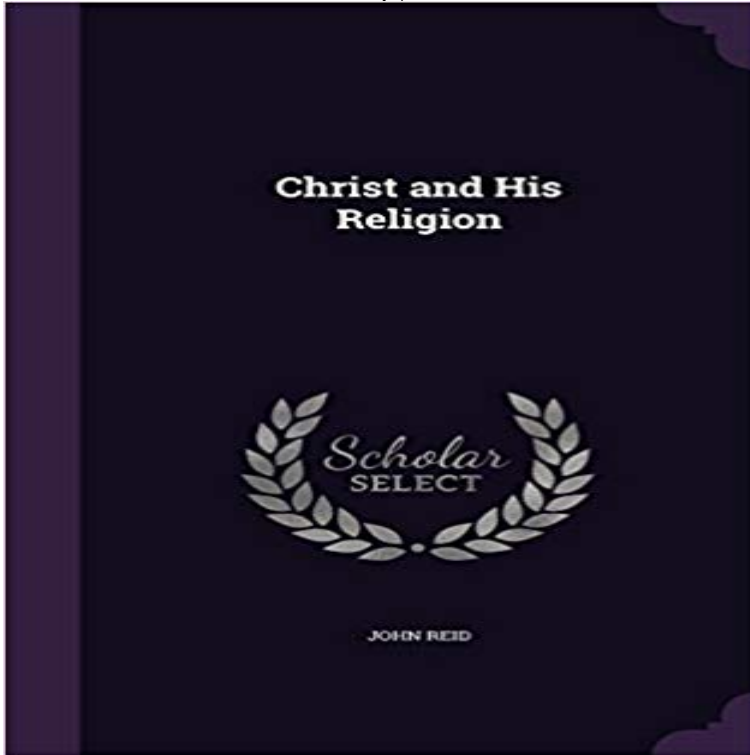


# Christ and His Religion
